

Queensland Ambulance Service (QAS)

- QAS supports and encourages high quality research designed to improve patient care, and is keen to collaborate on research projects.
- There is a formal process for applying for QAS data and access to QAS staff for the purposes of research.
- The service's Information Support, Research & Evaluation (ISRE) Unit, led by Dr Emma Bosley, manages this formal governance process.
- Consultation with the QAS ISRE Unit ahead of time is encouraged to ensure feasibility and that relevant data items are available.
- QAS accepts ethics review from National Health and Medical Research Council certified Human Research Ethics Committees.
- Applications for QAS data and access to QAS staff should include a brief letter addressed to the QAS Commissioner; an Application Form; a copy of the Research Protocol; and a copy of the ethics application and approval certificate.
