SAC Membership:

The SAC is comprised of up to eight (8) members:

- One Chair
- Up to three physicians or researchers with Emergency Medicine or related expertise
- Two nationally competitive health or medical researchers
- At least one EMF board member
- The EMF Research Manager or person(s) nominated by the General Manager.

The SAC meets every second month between 11am - 1pm at the EMF office in Milton. We encourage members to attend in person, however videoconference and teleconference facilities are available. In 2018, the meetings are as follows:

The purpose of the SAC is to:

- Provide strategic advice to the Board of Directors on scientific matters for the Emergency Medicine Foundation (EMF)
- Consider matters referred to it by the Board of Directors
- Audit research matters referred to it by EMF as well as complaints made to EMF
- Oversee an annual audit of EMF grant administration processes
