Call for Expressions of Interest

The Australasian College for Emergency Medicine (ACEM) is delighted to call for expressions of interest for the Board of the Emergency Medicine Foundation (EMF). This is the perfect opportunity for those aligned with EMF's vision and values to join a progressive Board.

Based in Brisbane, EMF is a national non-profit organisation funding innovative Australian research leading to robust, evidence-based solutions for Australia's emergency healthcare system. More information on EMF may be found at <https://emergencyfoundation.org.au/>

The EMF Board has four representational members nominated by ACEM who typically serve from one to three years. Two of the four ACEM representatives must be based in Queensland and two must be a FACEM. Interstate and regional candidates are encouraged to submit an EOI. EMF strives for diversity amongst its Board members. Clinicians actively providing care in an emergency department or retrieval service are preferred and maybe based in public, private or not-for-profit organisations.

In a new initiative, ACEM is open to supporting one representational Board member from nursing, paramedicine or allied health who has an active clinical role in emergency healthcare (emergency department or retrievals).

The Board is particularly interested in hearing from individuals with the following attributes:

- Board, governance or senior executive experience with AICD (or equivalent qualification) or a willingness to co-fund and complete AICD within three months of commencement
- Well networked across Commonwealth and/or State government and/or corporate sector and will enthusiastically advocate for and promote EMF
- Due diligence and integrity - understands fiduciary duties and the responsibility associated with governing an organisation
- Collaborative yet curious and courageous – able to work as part of a team
- Actively involved – time and emotional energy to commit to role and willing to serve on Board Committees

Meetings are held in Brisbane every second month and attendance may be in person or via audio-visual links. These Board roles are not remunerated although travel costs may be covered.
